

Movable Chords 105

The key to everything. Pick a **KEY** in the outer circle. That gives your root/**TONIC** note and your root major chord (which would be Roman Numeral **I** / **FIRST POSITION**).

Go **CLOCKWISE**  to find the **DOMINANT** chord (Roman **V** / **FIFTH POSITION**) for that key.

Go **ANTICLOCKWISE**  to find the **SUBDOMINANT** chord (Roman **IV** / **FOURTH POSITION**) for that key.

Those are your **PRIMARY** chords for the key you are playing in.

If it's C, then look in the **INNER** circle to find the **RELATIVE MINOR** chord for that key (Roman **vi** / **SIXTH POSITION**, which is minor chord – See Movable Chords 104, Scale Degrees).

Those are your **Magic Chords** which will play 80% of songs.
